Registration for both Online Campus and face-to-face Summer School will be online at www.gwinnettk12online.net.

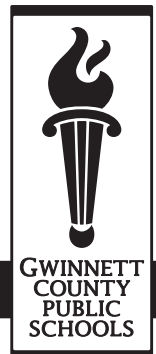
- **Online Campus registration:** May 1–June 5. Register by May 30 and save \$25 per course. In-person registration is not available for Online Campus classes.
- **Face-to-face Summer School registration:** May 1–June 5, with in-person registration at Berkmar High on May 30. (See green insert for details.)

Important information for face-to-face summer school and Online Campus students...

- Transportation is not provided for face-to-face summer school classes or for the face-to-face sessions required for Online Campus courses.
- A student should take no more than two summer classes: two face-to-face classes, two online classes, or a combination. Note: A block schedule class equals two classes.
- All tuition fees are due at the time of registration.
- Any student planning to walk in the summer school graduation ceremony must take all summer classes with Gwinnett County Public Schools.

- ♦ *Designated courses require state-mandated End of Course Tests (EOCT). These tests are administered in a face-to-face session at Buchanan HS of Technology during the testing window of July 7–9.*

Students retaking one of these courses previously failed must have taken the EOCT in order to enroll in the course again.

Registration begins May 1. Register by May 30 and save \$25.



Gwinnett County Online Campus 2009 Summer Semester

The online summer session is five weeks long and allows students to take courses to get ahead or to make-up a class previously failed. Online courses allow students to work at the time of day in which they learn the best and that best fits their schedule. Although the courses offer flexibility, they are not self-paced. Students have teacher-directed deadlines, due dates, and examinations. **Your counselor will review your choices after you submit your summer school selections online.** See the frequently asked questions and answers below and a list of course offerings on the other side of this flyer. **For additional questions, ask your counselor or see the website.**

Frequently Asked Questions About Gwinnett County Online Campus

What is the cost of an Online Campus course?

Each online semester course (.5 unit) is \$250 (\$225 if you register by May 30). Each online block course (1.0 unit) is \$500 (\$450 if you register by May 30).

How do I register and pay for online classes?

Register online at www.gwinnettk12online.net between May 1 and June 5. Online Campus accepts payment by VISA and Mastercard only. Note: Online Campus does NOT accept cash or personal checks. All registration is handled online.

What are important summer dates for the Online Campus?

May 1–June 5 Online registration

May 21 or 27 Information session (*optional*), 6:30 p.m., Buchanan HS of Technology, Bldg. A (Theater), located at 2595 Beaver Ruin Rd. in Norcross

June 8 or 9 Materials pick-up is required for some courses, any time, 1–5 p.m., Buchanan HS of Technology, Bldg. E. *See the gray box in this brochure for the list of courses that require materials pick-up.*

June 10 On June 10, students *must* complete the online Orientation Course (OR101) and OR101 quiz. In this mandatory course, students will find a link to a recorded subject introduction. In addition to listening to the introduction, students *must* complete an assignment related to their course. **Failure to complete these tasks on June 10— the orientation course, quiz, recorded subject introduction, and related assignment— will result in being dropped from the course.**

June 11 Open Lab, 1–5 p.m, Buchanan HS of Technology, Bldg. D (*for students who need technical assistance with any of the course tools, such as uploading homework, document sharing, taking tests/quizzes, etc.*)

**Check website and/or your course announcements for date/time. Final exams and EOCTs will be administered in a face-to-face meeting with your teacher at Buchanan HS of Technology.*

Do I have to log-in to my course every day?

Yes, you must have *daily access* to a reliable computer with an Internet connection to log-in to your course. You will need to log-in each day during the school week (Monday to Friday) during the entire summer session. An online course requires 15–20 hours a week per course during the shorter, more intensive summer classes.

How many online courses can I take at one time?

Online Campus allows students to take no more than two courses (or one block course) during the summer, including any face-to-face summer school classes. Online Campus does NOT allow students to take a full unit of any course when the first semester is a prerequisite for the second.

What is an online class like?

An online class is similar to a face-to-face class in the following ways. There is a teacher. You have lessons. You have homework, due dates, class discussions, and tests. The difference is that these activities occur over the Internet and students may “attend” class at any time of the day. However, you are required to log-in to class daily Monday through Friday for the entire session.

What is the structure of a course?

On June 10, students *must* complete mandatory orientation activities, including the online Orientation Course (OR101) and quiz, the recorded introduction, and the related assignment. Essentially, these activities are your *virtual* first day of class. In the orientation, you will learn more about your online course. For most classes, all class work is done online. The exceptions are science, health, and PE classes, which require additional face-to-face labs or activities. All classes have face-to-face exams at the end of the summer session. You'll learn more in your online orientation.

What about final exams and other tests?

All classes require either a final exam or the state's End of Course Test (EOCT). These tests are administered in a face-to-face session with your teacher at Buchanan HS of Technology. The window for EOCTs, required by the state for designated courses, is July 7–9. The final exam window for all other classes is July 13–14. You will return your materials on exam day.

What if I want to withdraw and receive a course refund?

With parental approval, Online summer students can drop courses up until June 10 and request a refund by email (gwinnettonline@gwinnett.k12.ga.us). Refunds are subject to a \$25 administrative processing fee. No refunds will be given after June 10.
